- 1. Take numerous photos (to include; front and back of leaf(s), stem and branch, buds or bud scars, whole plant if possible, plant in its natural setting).
- 2. Photos should be clear and of a relatively high resolution (150-300 DPI)

A) Images of the front and the back of the leaf(s).



B) Images of the tree form.



C) Images of the stem and branch.



D) Images of the buds (if applicable).



E) Incude images of the fruits (if applicable).



F) Incude images of the bark (*if applicable*).

Other useful images include; leaf arrangement, leaf form, flowers, thorns or other unusual structures (if applicable).
