Duties Include:

- Organizing, scheduling, and leading community science, environmental, nature, and conservation education programs at neighborhood parks, community centers, and other venues
- Organizing and leading interpretive programs and hikes in local parks
- Organizing volunteer opportunities and leading volunteer groups
- Supporting and providing nature programming at Park and Recreation summer camps
- Providing assistance during special events and projects
- Other duties as assigned

Minimum Requirements:

- Successful applicants must have some college experience relevant to natural resource management, conservation, and environmental education
- One year of experience delivering public programming
- Ability to relate well to people of all ages and backgrounds
- Self-motivated and able to work independently outdoors in a variety of conditions
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
